Act No. 48 of 1976

AN ACT to provide for the Supplementary Appropriation
for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year
ending on the 31st day of December, 1976.

[Assented to 10th December, 1976]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Short title
Supplementary Appropriation (No. 4) Act, 1976.

Further issue of one hundred and fifty-nine million, eight hundred and seventy-four thousand three hundred and nineteen dollars from the Consolidated Fund authorised.

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of one hundred and fifty-nine million, eight hundred and seventy-four thousand, three hundred and nineteen dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1976, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the said Schedule opposite a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said one hundred and fifty-nine million, eight hundred and seventy-four thousand, three hundred and nineteen dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that Head in the Supplementary Estimates for 1976.
