AN ACT to amend the Solicitors Ordinance.

[Assented to 14th June, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Solicitors (Amend- ^{Short title}
ment) Act, 1976.

2. Section 18 of the Solicitors Ordinance is repealed and replaced as follows:—

“Application
of Part IIIA

18. No person shall be qualified to be admitted as a solicitor under this Part unless—

- (a) in the case of a person who is not a national, he was so qualified on 1st October, 1972;
- (b) in the case of a national, he attains the qualification under this Part on or before the 31st December, 1980.”.
