Act No. 35 of 1974

AN ACT to provide for the Supplementary Appropriation for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1974.

[Assented to 10th December, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment} and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary ^{Short title} Appropriation Act, 1974.

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of eighty-seven million, nine hundred and forty thousand, five hundred and sixty-one dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service in respect of the year ending 31st December, 1974, under the Head of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule is hereby appropriated for the purposes specified in relation to that Head in the Supplementary Estimates for 1974.
