AN ACT to amend the Supreme Court of Judicature Act,
1962.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supreme Court of Short title
Judicature (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1980.

2. Section 81A of the Supreme Court of Judicature Act, 1962 is repealed and replaced as follows—

“Qualifica-
tions for
admission
as a barris-
ter

81A. A person shall be qualified to be admitted as a barrister if—

- (a) he is the holder of a Legal Certificate of Education awarded by the Council of Legal Education; or
- (b) he was called to the Bar of England.”.
