**Act No. 23 of 1979**

AN ACT relating to the pension rights of the office of  
Special Adviser to the Cabinet on all Protective  
Services and Chief Executive Officer of the National  
Security Council.

*[Assented 10th July, 1979]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Special Adviser to the Short title  
Cabinet (Protective Services) (Pension Rights) Act, 1979.

Special Adviser  
to enjoy Police  
Service Pension  
Rights

2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, it is hereby declared that the person holding the office of Special Adviser to the Cabinet on all Protective Services and Chief Executive Officer of the National Security Council shall continue to enjoy pension rights similar to those enjoyed by him as the holder of an office in the Police Service.

Commencement

3. This Act is deemed to have come into operation on 20th October, 1978.
