MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE UNION PARK RACES (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
ORDER, 1989

1. This Order may be cited as the Union Park Races (Temporary Provisions) Citation Order, 1989.

2. This Order comes into operation at 10.00 a.m. and ceases at 7.00 p.m. Commence-  
ment on each of the undermentioned dates—

- Saturday, 11th February, 1989;
- Saturday, 18th February, 1989;
- Saturday, 25th February, 1989;
- Saturday, 4th March, 1989;
- Saturday, 11th March, 1989;
- Saturday, 25th March, 1989;
- Monday, 27th March, 1989;
- Saturday, 1st April, 1989;
- Saturday, 8th April, 1989;
- Saturday, 15th April, 1989; and
- Saturday, 22nd April, 1989.

3. No person shall park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain on any of the roads mentioned below during the times and dates specified in paragraph 2— Parking prohibited on certain roads

- (a) Guaracara-Tabaquite Road, between the Southern Main Road and Battoo Avenue;
- (b) Union Road; and
- (c) the roads of Gopaul Lands.

4. Parking on Union Park shall be as follows—

- (a) committee members and stewards—on spaces immediately North and South of the main entrance to the Stand; and
- (b) members of the New Union Park Race Club—West to the paddock and on the northern side of Guaracara-Tabaquite Road and Harmony Hall Road. Special parking

5. Between 5.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. on the dates specified in paragraph 2, vehicles travelling along the Guaracara-Tabaquite Road between the Southern Main Road and Union Road shall proceed in an easterly direction only. One-way traffic

- Approach to Union Park      6. Between 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on the dates specified in paragraph 2, vehicles approaching Union Park from a southerly direction shall proceed along Gopaul Road.
- Exit from Union Park      7. Between 5.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. on the dates specified in paragraph 2, vehicles leaving Union Park shall proceed in a westerly direction along Gopaul Road.
- Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked Chap. 48:50      8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
