AN ACT to amend the Students Cess Act, 1989

[Assented to 14th September, 1990]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Students Cess short title (Amendment) Act, 1990.
