REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 76 OF THE  
EXCISE (GENERAL PROVISIONS) ACT

THE EXCISE (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1999

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Exercise (Fees) Citation  
(Amendment) Regulations, 1999.
2. In these Regulations, “the Regulations” means the Excise (Fees) Interpretation  
Regulations. Chap. 78:50
3. The Regulations are amended in regulation 6— Regulation 6  
amended
  - (a) in paragraph (a)—
    - (i) in subparagraph (i), by deleting the words “\$32.46”  
and substituting the words “\$40.88”; and
    - (ii) in subparagraph (ii), by deleting the words “\$32.46”  
and “\$43.27” and substituting the words “\$40.88”  
and “\$54.49” respectively;
  - (b) in paragraph (b)—
    - (i) in subparagraph (i), by deleting the words “\$30.02”  
and substituting the words “\$34.56”; and
    - (ii) in subparagraph (ii), by deleting the words “\$30.02”  
and “\$40.03” and substituting the words “\$34.56”  
and “\$46.09” respectively.
4. The Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 6, the Regulation 7  
following new regulation: inserted
  7. (1) The overtime fees in respect of the services of  
“Overtime officers out of normal office hours are payable to the  
fees for 1989 Comptroller at the rates and for the years set out in the  
to 1998 Schedule.  
Schedule
  - (2) The fees set out in the Schedule in respect of—
    - (a) the years 1989 to 1995, are deemed to have  
come into effect on 1st January, 1989;

(b) the year 1996, is deemed to have come into effect on 1st January, 1996;

(c) the year 1997, is deemed to have come into effect on 1st January, 1997; and

(d) the year 1998, is deemed to have come into effect on 1st January, 1998.

(3) Notwithstanding subregulation (1), any person who utilised any of the services mentioned in the Schedule shall be exempt from the payment of any sums of monies representing the difference between the rates which were payable, in respect of those services, before 1st January, 1989 and the rates set out in the Schedule.”.

On Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays	\$29.85 for every hour or part thereof for the first eight hours and thereafter \$39.80 for each hour or part thereof.	\$32.90 for every hour or part thereof for the first eight hours and thereafter \$43.87 for each hour or part thereof.	\$33.56 for every hour or part thereof for the first eight hours and thereafter \$44.75 for each hour or part thereof.	\$34.56 for every hour or part thereof for the first eight hours and thereafter \$46.09 for each hour or part thereof.”.
