REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 76 OF THE
EXCISE (GENERAL PROVISIONS) ACT

THE EXCISE (FEES) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 2002

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Excise (Fees) Citation
(Amendment) Regulations, 2002.

2. In these Regulations, “Regulation” or “Regulations” means the Interpretation
Excise (Fees) Regulations. Chap. 78:50

3. Regulation 6 is amended— Regulation 6
amended

(a) in paragraph (a)—

(i) in subparagraph (i), by deleting the words “\$40.88”
and substituting the words “45.60”; and

(ii) in subparagraph (ii), by deleting the words “\$40.88”
and “\$59.49” and substituting the words “\$45.60” and
\$60.79” respectively;

(b) in paragraph (b)—

(i) in subparagraph (i), by deleting the words “\$34.56”
and substituting the words “\$38.67”; and

(ii) in subparagraph (ii), by deleting the words “\$34.56”
and “\$46.09” and substituting the words “\$38.67” and
“\$51.55” respectively.

4. Regulation 7 is revoked and the following regulation is substituted: Regulation 7
amended

“Overtime fees

7. (1) The overtime fees in respect of the services
of officers out of normal office hours are payable to the
Comptroller at the rates and for the years set out in the
Schedule.

Schedule

(2) The fees set out in the Schedule in respect
of—

(a) the year 1999, are deemed to have come
into effect on 1st January, 1999;

- (b) the year 2000, are deemed to have come into effect on 1st January, 2000; and
- (c) the year 2001, are deemed to have come into effect on 1st January, 2001.

(3) Notwithstanding subregulation (1), any person who utilised any of the services mentioned in the Schedule shall be exempt from the payment of any sums of monies representing the difference between the rates which were payable, in respect of those services, before 1st January, 1999 and the rates set out in the Schedule.”.

Schedule amended

5. The Schedule is repealed and the following Schedule is substituted:

PART B

Receiving or delivering spirits from warehouse or any other services—each guard:

On ordinary weekdays	\$35.76 for each hour or part thereof.	\$36.47 for each hour or part thereof.	\$38.67 for each hour or part thereof.
On Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays	\$35.76 for each hour or part thereof for the first eight hours and thereafter \$47.67 for each hour or part thereof.	\$36.47 for each hour or part thereof for the first eight hours and thereafter \$48.62 for each hour or part thereof.	\$38.67 for each hour or part thereof for the first eight hours and thereafter \$51.55 for each hour or part thereof.”.
