ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the 1949 Supplementary Appropriation Ordinance, 1951.

The further sum of four million four hundred and eighty-seven thousand one hundred and sixty-six dollars and forty-five cents shall be charged upon the Revenue and other Funds of the Colony for certain public services for the year ended on the 31st day of December, 1949, to be appropriated as set out in the First Schedule hereto.

The further sum of one hundred and twenty-nine thousand seven hundred and ninety-six dollars and fourteen cents shall be charged upon the Revenue and other Funds of the Trinidad Government Railways and Telegraphs (including Road Transport) for certain public services for the year ended on the 31st day of December, 1949, to be appropriated as set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

The further sum of two hundred and twenty-one thousand and fifty-eight dollars and sixty-four cents shall be charged upon Revenue and other Funds of the Port Services Department for certain public services for the year ended on the 31st day of December, 1949, to be appropriated as set out in the Third Schedule hereto.
