Act No. 7 of 1967

AN ACT to provide for Supplementary Appropriation for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1967.

[Assented to 6th May, 1967]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Approp- Short titleriation Act, 1967.

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of eleven million and ninety seven thousand dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1967, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the said Schedule opposite a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of eleven million and ninety seven thousand dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that Head in the Supplementary Estimates for 1967.
