Act No. 17 of 1962

AN ACT to provide for Supplementary Appropriation to the Service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1962.

[Assented to 30th August, 1962]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Short title Supplementary Appropriation Act, 1962.

2. A further sum not exceeding eleven million, five hundred and ninety-eight thousand, and twenty-six dollars shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the Consolidated Fund for the service of the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1962.

3. The further sum charged by Section 2 of this Act is hereby appropriated to the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule to this Act, and shall be deemed to have been so appropriated from the 1st day of January, 1962.
