Act No. 38 of 1971

AN ACT to provide for Supplementary Appropriation for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st December, 1971.

[Assented to 22nd December, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment} and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 1971. ^{Short title}

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of five million, eight hundred and forty thousand, five hundred and five dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1971, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule.
