AN ACT for making Supplementary Appropriation for the Public Services of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ended on the 31st day of December, 1971.

[Assented to 22nd October, 1971]¹

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

2. The further sum of forty-five million, nine hundred and sixty-seven thousand, four hundred and ten dollars shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the Consolidated Fund for certain public services for the year ended on the 31st day of December, 1971.

3. The sum charged by section 2 is hereby appropriated to the services and for the purposes expressed in the Schedule and shall be deemed to have been so appropriated from the 1st day of January, 1971.
