Act No. 33 of 1967

AN ACT to provide for Supplementary Appropriation for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1967.

[Assented to 4th December, 1967]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Second Supplementary ^{Short title} Appropriation Act, 1967.

Issue of

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of two hundred thousand dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1967, under the Head of Expenditure set out in the Schedule; and the sum so set out is hereby appropriated for the purposes specified in relation to that Head in Supplementary Estimates for the said year.
