AN ORDINANCE to authorize the raising of a sum of £100,000 for the establishment of a system of sewerage for the Town of Port-of-Spain and its suburbs, and the construction of the Works connected therewith.

**W**HEREAS by the Railway Extension and Public Works Loan Ordinances 1894-5, the Governor is authorized at such times and by such instalments as might be deemed expedient to borrow two several sums of £400,000 and £100,000 by means of Inscribed Stock under the provisions of the General Loan and Inscribed Stock Ordinance, 1890, to be applied exclusively to the several public works therein respectively mentioned.

And whereas it is expedient to authorize the Governor to borrow a further sum of £100,000 to be applied exclusively to the establishment of a system

of sewerage and works connected therewith for the town of Port-of-Spain and its suburbs.

Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title.      1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port-of-Spain Suburban Sewerage Ordinance, 1896.

Construction.      It shall be read as one with the Railway Extension and Public Works Loan Ordinances, 1894-5.

The Railway Extension and Public Works Loan Ordinances, 1894-5, may together with this Ordinance be cited as the Railway Extension and Public Works Loan Ordinances, 1894-96.

Governor may raise £100,000 by sale of stock.      2. It shall be lawful for the Governor at such times and by such instalments as may be deemed expedient to borrow a further sum not exceeding £100,000 by the Sale of Inscribed Stock under the provisions of "The General Loan and Inscribed Stock Ordinance, 1890," to be applied exclusively to the establishment of a system of sewerage and works connected therewith for the town of Port-of-Spain and its suburbs.

Passed in Council this Sixth day of July, in the year of Our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six.
