AN ORDINANCE to amend the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, No. 1.

[11th November, 1915.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1915.

Repeal of 23 of No. 1

2. Section 23 of the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance (No. 1) is hereby repealed.

Head of Department may authorise officer in his Department to appear for him.

3.—(1.) The Head of a Department shall not be bound to attend in a Summary Court to conduct any proceedings in which he is a complainant, but may, by writing under his hand, authorise any subordinate officer of his Department to conduct such proceedings on his behalf.

(2.) If any question arises as to whether any officer of the Government is the Head of a Department, a certificate

in writing under the hand of the Colonial Secretary to that effect shall be conclusive evidence on the question.
