AN ORDINANCE to provide for a loan to the San Fernando Waterworks Authority.

WHEREAS the San Fernando District Waterworks Authority are desirous of raising a loan of £3,000 for the purpose of relaying and carrying out improvements in connection with the water mains of the San Fernando Waterworks ;

And whereas the Mayor and Burgesses of San Fernando have agreed to undertake the repayment of the said loan ;

And whereas in view of the provisions of the Municipal Corporations Ordinance No. 210 and the District Waterworks Ordinance No. 223, legislative authority is necessary to provide for the raising of the said loan and the repayment thereof by the said Mayor and Burgesses ;

Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

- Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the San Fernando Waterworks Loan Ordinance 1910.
- Loan to San Fernando Water Authority. 2. The Receiver-General may, on the authority of the Governor, from moneys in his hands, advance by way of loan to the San Fernando District Waterworks Authority the sum of £3,000 for the purposes aforesaid.
- Repayment of loan. 3. Such sum of £3,000 shall be a charge upon the general revenues of the Borough of San Fernando, and shall be repayable to the Receiver-General by thirty-five annual instalments of one hundred and fifty pounds each by the Mayor and Burgesses of the said Borough out of the said general revenues.
- Payment of instalment. 4. Such annual instalments shall be paid on or before the thirtieth day of June in each year, and the first of such instalments shall be paid on or before the thirtieth day of June, 1911.

Passed in Council this thirty-first day of January, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and ten.
