AN ORDINANCE to amend the Stamp Duty Ordinance  
1908 (No. 28 of 1908).

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Stamp Duty Short title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance 1908.

2. The Schedule to the Stamp Duty Ordinance 1908 is Correction of  
clerical errors.  
hereby amended as follows:—

(a.) In lieu of “announcement o” in the first line  
under the first of the headings “Articles of  
Clerkship” shall be read “commencement of.”

(b.) The words and figures:

“Bail Bond ... .. 0 0 1”  
shall be omitted.

- (c.) After the heading "Duplicate or counterpart" shall be read:—

"EXCHANGE, PARTITION OR DIVISION,  
Instrument effecting, if not otherwise charged  
by this Ordinance ... .. £0 10 0  
And see Section 59."

and the following words and figures occurring after the heading "Notice" are hereby struck out:

"PARTITION OR DIVISION—EXCHANGE—  
Instrument effecting, if not otherwise charged  
by this Ordinance ... .. £0 10 0  
And see Section 59."

and in lieu thereof shall be read:

"PARTITION, DIVISION OR EXCHANGE, see EXCHANGE."

- (d.) Under the heading "POLICY OF INSURANCE," in lieu of "Section 78" shall be read "Section 68."

- (e.) Under the heading "POLICY OF SEA INSURANCE—  
For or upon any voyage"  
after  
"fractional part of £100"  
shall be read "£0 0 3."

- (f.) Under the heading "RECEIPT—*Exemptions*" in the second line of (5) in lieu of "or" shall be read "of."
