AN ORDINANCE to amend the Savings Bank Ordinance.

[7th April, 1927.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Savings Bank Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1927, and shall be read as one Construction. with the Savings Bank Ordinance, hereinafter called the Cap. 109. Principal Ordinance.

2. Sub-section (2) of section 10 of the Principal Ordinance Interest on deposits. is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :—

(2) At the close of business on the thirty-first day of December in each year the interest due up to and including that day shall be added to the principal.
