AN ORDINANCE for the incorporation of certain persons  
as Trustees of St. Mary's College.

[9th June, 1925.]

WHEREAS the educational institution in Port-of-Spain known as St. Mary's College of the Immaculate Conception (hereinafter called "the College") is administered by the Superior of the College aided by a body known as the Advisory Council;

And whereas by resolution of the said Advisory Council duly passed on the 2nd day of June, 1924, the Revd. James Lacy, the Revd. James Duggan and the Revd. James MacDonnell were appointed Trustees of the said College;

And whereas the said the Revd. James Lacy died on the 14th day of January, 1925;

And whereas by resolution duly passed on the 20th day of January, 1925, the Revd. John O'Donoghue was appointed one of such Trustees in the place of the said Revd. James Lacy, deceased;

And whereas it is expedient that the said Trustees should be incorporated and should have power to hold land and other property in trust for the College ;

BE it therefore enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

- Short title.      **1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the St. Mary's College Trustees Ordinance, 1925.
- Incorporation of Trustees.      **2.** The said James Duggan, James MacDonnell and John O'Donoghue and their successors in office as such Trustees as aforesaid shall be and are hereby created a body corporate by the name of " The Incorporated Trustees of St. Mary's College " and by that name shall have perpetual succession and shall and may sue and be sued in all Courts of justice in the Colony and shall have and use a common seal, which may from time to time be changed. Such seal shall only be used in the presence of at least two of the Trustees, and shall not be changed except by resolution of the Trustees at a meeting held for the purpose, such resolution to be published in the *Royal Gazette* as soon after such meeting as possible.
- Property vested in Trustees.      **3.** The properties specified in the Schedule hereto and all other property real and personal of what nature soever now vested in any person or persons for and on behalf of the College shall be and the same are hereby vested in the Incorporated Trustees.
- Trustees may acquire property.      **4.** The Incorporated Trustees shall, subject to the rules, regulations and control of the said Advisory Council, have full power to acquire for the College by purchase, exchange, demise, gift, bequest or otherwise real and personal property in the Colony or any estate or interest therein, and also any money, securities for money, goods or chattels whatsoever.
- Trustees may dispose of property.      **5.** It shall be lawful for the Trustees, subject to such rules, regulations and control as aforesaid, from time to time by deed under their seal to sell, demise, grant, convey, exchange or otherwise dispose of any property vested or which may hereafter be vested in them.

6. Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of His Majesty His Heirs or Successors or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any other persons except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Ordinance and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
