AN ORDINANCE to amend the San Fernando Improvement Loan Ordinance, 1921.

[ *31<sup>st</sup>* December, 1921.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the San Fernando Improvement Loan (Amendment) Ordinance, 1921, and shall be read as one with the San Fernando Improvement Loan Ordinance, 1921, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance. Short title.  
Construction.

2. The following section shall be inserted as section 4a of the Principal Ordinance: 4a  
Coupons to be  
attached to  
debentures.

4a. There shall be attached to every debenture coupons for the payment of interest to become due in each half year upon the principal represented by the debenture. The coupons shall be sufficient in number to provide for the

payment of interest during the whole period for which the debenture has to run.

3. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be inserted the following:—

5. The debentures and the coupons attached thereto shall be in the form given in the schedule to this Ordinance, and shall be under the seal of the Mayor and Burgesses of San Fernando and shall be signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the Town Clerk and Treasurer of the said Borough.

4. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be inserted the following:—

7. Every debenture and coupon and the right to receive the principal and interest represented thereby shall be transferable by delivery.

5. In lieu of the schedule to the Principal Ordinance shall be inserted the following:—

#### SAN FERNANDO IMPROVEMENT DEBENTURE.

This debenture issued this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and \_\_\_\_\_ under the authority of the Ordinance intituled "The San Fernando Improvement Loan Ordinance, 1921," entitles the holder to be paid by the Mayor and Burgesses of San Fernando at the office in San Fernando of the Town Clerk and Treasurer of the said Borough, the principal sum of \_\_\_\_\_ on the thirtieth day of June, in the year in which it may be redeemed in the manner provided by the said Ordinance and interest for the same at the rate of \_\_\_\_\_ pounds per centum per annum from the date hereof half-yearly on the thirtieth day of June and the thirty-first day of December, in each year. In payment of the said principal and interest the assets and general revenues of the Borough of San Fernando stand charged by the said Ordinance.
