AN ORDINANCE to amend the Spirits and Spirit
Compounds Ordinance, No. 176.

[25th November, 1921.]


BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. The Spirits (Excise duty) Ordinance, 1920, (No. 25 of Repeal.
1920) is hereby repealed.

2. Section 90 of the Spirits and Spirit Compounds ^{Duty on}
Ordinance, No. 176, is hereby amended by substituting the ^{spirits.}
word "eleven" for the word "eight" in the sixth line.
