AN ORDINANCE to amend the Quarantine Ordinance, 1910.

[1st December, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Quarantine Short Title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1916.

2. Section 41 of the Quarantine Ordinance, 1910, is hereby repealed and the following shall be inserted in lieu thereof:— Amendment of Section 41 of Ordinance 17—1910.

41.—(1.) Until payment of any expenses made payable under Sections 16, 25, 33 and 34, or under any Rules and Regulations under this Ordinance, the Collector of Customs and the Harbour Master may refuse to clear any vessel in respect of which any such liability to pay has been incurred.

(2.) Any such expenses may be recovered in a summary manner before any Magistrate.
