AN ORDINANCE to amend the Stamp Duty Ordinance,  
1908 (No. 28).

[20th May, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Stamp Duty Short Title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1916.

2. Section 77 of the Stamp Duty Ordinance, 1908 is Amendment  
of Section 77  
of Ordinance  
28—1908.  
amended by inserting the following as Sub-section (2) of  
such section:—

(2.) Proceedings under the provisions of this section  
may be taken at any time within twelve months  
from the time when the cause of complaint  
arose.
