AN ORDINANCE to amend the School Teachers' Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 14. No. 5.

Commencement.

[1st January, 1944.]

Enactment.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the School Teachers' Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, and shall be read Ch. 14.No. 5. as one with the School Teachers' Pensions Ordinance.

2. The following proviso is hereby added to section 8 of the School Teachers' Pensions Ordinance :—

Proviso added
to section 8
of Ch. 14.
No. 5.

“ Provided that the pension of a headteacher of a primary school who immediately prior to his retirement was in receipt of a seniority allowance in addition to his salary shall be computed on the aggregate of his salary and such allowance which for the purposes of the said computation shall be deemed to be additional salary.”

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have been in operation from the 1st January, 1944.
