Sulphonamide Drugs

E NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment.
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sulphonamide Drugs Short title.
Ordinance, 1946.

- Regulations. 2. The Governor in Council may make regulations—
 (a) for controlling the sale and use of any drug specified in the Schedule to this Ordinance ;
 (b) prescribing penalties for the breach of any such regulation.
- Validity of Regulations,
 Ch. 12, No. 2. 3. The validity of any regulation made under the authority of the preceding section shall not be affected by anything contained in Part IV of the Medical Board Ordinance.
- Power of Governor in Council to add to list of drugs in Schedule. 4. The Governor in Council may, by Order, add any sulphonamide drug to the list of drugs specified in the Schedule to this Ordinance.

SCHEDULE.

Para-aminobenzene sulphonamide ;

Its salts ;

Derivatives of para-aminobenzene sulphonamide having one or both of the hydrogen atoms of the para-amino group or of the sulphonamide group, substituted by other radicals ;

Their salts ;

The derivatives shall include—

Sulphonamidochrysoidin

Azosulphamide

Benzylsulphanilamide

Sulphanilyldimethyl sulphanilamide

Sulphapyridine

Sulphathiazole

Sulphacetamide

Sulphadiazine

Sulphaguanidine

Sulphamezathine

Succinyl sulphathiazole.
