AN ORDINANCE to amend the Separation and Maintenance Ordinance, Ch. 5. No. 15.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Ch. 5. No. 15.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Separation and Maintenance (Amendment) Ordinance, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Separation and Maintenance Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and shall come into force on such date as the Governor may by proclamation appoint.

2. Subsection (1) of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by deleting the words "all or" from the first paragraph thereof;

(b) by substituting the words "such weekly sum as the court may consider reasonable" for the words "a weekly sum not exceeding two dollars" appearing in paragraph (d) thereof.

3. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words "for the maintenance" for the words "on the application".

4. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words "such weekly sum as the court may consider reasonable" for the words "a weekly sum not exceeding two dollars" appearing in paragraph (b) of the proviso thereto.
