AN ORDINANCE to amend the School Teachers' Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 14. No. 5.

**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title.

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the School Teachers' Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1946 and shall be read as one with the School Teachers' Pensions Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (2) of Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words "on or with a view to marriage" wherever they appear therein and by substituting therefor the words "for the reason that she is married or is about to marry".
