AN ORDINANCE to amend the Slum Clearance and Housing
(Temporary Provisions) Ordinance, 1944.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Slum Clearance and Housing (Temporary Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Slum Clearance and Housing (Temporary Provisions) Ordinance, 1944, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“(c) Whenever the Committee has under consideration any matter affecting the area of a Local Authority, the Committee shall co-opt as members of the said Committee one member of such Local Authority, who shall be nominated by such Local Authority, and the Medical Officer of Health of such Local Authority, and such co-opted members shall have the right of deliberating and voting in the same manner as any other member of the Committee.”
