AN ORDINANCE to authorise the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of San Fernando to raise a loan for the purposes of repaying moneys loaned to them by the Government during the year 1941, of meeting the increased cost of carrying out improvements to their Electric Lighting System, and of defraying the expenses of a Drainage and Street Improvement Scheme.

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 33. *San Fernando (Redemption of Loans and Improvement) Loan. 1944.*

Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the San Fernando (Redemption of Loans and Improvement) Loan Ordinance, 1944.

Authority to raise loan. 2. The Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of San Fernando (hereinafter referred to as the Corporation) may raise by loan an amount sufficient to produce as nearly as may be the sum of five hundred thousand dollars and such further sum as may be necessary to defray the expenses of raising such loan.

Application of loan. 3. (1) Any sum raised to defray the expenses of issue shall be applied only to that purpose.  
(2) Save as aforesaid the money borrowed under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be appropriated and applied to the purposes specified in the Schedule to this Ordinance :

Provided that it shall be lawful for the Corporation with the prior sanction of the Governor in Council to utilise any sum not required in respect of any one of the items in the Schedule for the purposes of any other or others of those items.

Method of raising loan. 4. The loan hereby authorised to be raised and every part of it shall be raised in the Colony under the provisions of the General Local Loan (Municipal Corporations) Ordinance, and the provisions of the said Ordinance shall apply accordingly.

Contribution to Sinking Fund. 5. The contributions to the Sinking Fund, as contemplated by the provisions of the General Local Loan (Municipal Corporations) Ordinance, shall commence in respect of any issue of debentures under that Ordinance for the purposes of the loan hereby authorised not later than one year after the date from which the interest on such issue shall commence to run.

Advances by Accountant General. 6. Pending the issue of the whole or any portion of the loan hereby authorised to be raised the Governor may, if necessary, authorise the Accountant General to make advances to be applied to the purposes in the Schedule to this Ordinance.
