1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Solicitors Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1945.

An amendment
of section 18
of Ordinance
No. 33 of 1942.

2. Section 18 of the Solicitors Ordinance, 1942, is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following subsection :—

“(5) A person shall not be disqualified by sex from being admitted as a solicitor.”
