## AN ORDINANCE to amend the School Teachers' Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 14. No. 5.

Commencement.

[20th December, 1941.]

Short Title.

Ch. 14. No. 5.

Section 14 of the  
Principal Ordinance amended.

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the School Teachers' Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1941, and shall be read as one with the School Teachers' Pensions Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

**2.** Section 14 of the Principal Ordinance, is hereby amended by inserting immediately after subsection (1) a new subsection numbered (1A) as follows:—

(1A) It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, by notification published in the *Royal Gazette*, to declare that any teacher who has inadvertently omitted to exercise the option mentioned in subsection (1) shall be deemed to have duly exercised such option, and thereupon this section shall apply to such teacher as though he had exercised the option in accordance with the subsection.
