AN ORDINANCE to amend the School Teachers' Pensions
Ordinance, 1929.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the School Teachers' Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1936, and shall be construed as one with the School Teachers' Pensions Ordinance, 1929, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title.
Construction.

2. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following :—

" 10.—(1) Every teacher, otherwise qualified for a pension, who has not completed 10 years service, may on retirement be granted a gratuity at a rate not exceeding one-twelfth of a month's salary for each completed month of service ; Gratuities.
