AN ORDINANCE to amend the Explosives Ordinance,
1907.

[22nd November, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Explosives Short Title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1916.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained Storage of explosives in Government magazine.
in the Explosives Ordinance, 1907, it shall be lawful for the Government to provide a magazine in which explosives, other than gunpowder and safety cartridges, imported into the Colony may be stored.

3. The Governor in Executive Council may make regula- Regulations.
tions to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance, and particularly may make regulations relating to

(a.) the conditions under which explosives may be stored in such magazine ;

-
- (b.) the rent to be paid and the times at, and the manner in which such rent shall be payable or recoverable;
 - (c.) the sale or disposal of explosives in respect of which any rent may be in arrears and the manner in which the proceeds of any such sale shall be dealt with.
