NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A
PUBLIC PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the strip of land described in the Schedule and measuring approximately 3.5 kilometres in length and 25 metres in width, extending in an easterly direction from the existing Store Bay Local Road, traversing lands belonging now or formerly to Horace Charles, Kilgwin and Friendship Estates and others and ending at the Cove Estate is land likely to be required for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: extension of the Store Bay Local Road.

SCHEDULE

A strip of land measuring approximately 3.5 kilometres in length and 25 metres in width, extending in an easterly direction from the existing Store Bay Local Road, traversing lands owned now or formerly by Horace Charles, Kilgwin and Friendship Estates and others and ending at the Cove Estate.
