THE LAND ACQUISITION (POSSESSION OF LAND PRIOR TO  
FORMAL VESTING IN THE STATE) (NO. 14) ORDER, 2007

1. This Order may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Possession of <sup>Citation</sup>  
Land Prior to Formal Vesting in the State) (No. 14) Order, 2007.

2. The Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Works and <sup>Possession of</sup>  
Transport is authorized to take possession of a parcel of land <sup>land</sup>  
comprising 540 square metres more or less, known as Lot 39,  
Naparima-Mayaro Road, Cocoyea Village and situate at Naparima-  
Mayaro Road, in the Ward of Naparima, in the County of Victoria, said  
to belong now or formerly to Mary Temple and described in the  
Notification in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*, Volume 46, No. 56,  
dated 3rd April, 2007, at Item No. 590, as Legal Notice No. 77 of 2007,  
before the formal vesting of the land in the State and to apply it for the  
purpose for which it is intended to be put on acquisition.
