THE PETROLEUM ACT, CHAP. 62:01

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 29 OF THE PETROLEUM ACT
AND SUBJECT TO NEGATIVE RESOLUTION OF PARLIAMENT

THE PETROLEUM (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2012

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Petroleum (Amendment) Citation
Regulations, 2012.

2. The Petroleum Regulations are amended in regulation 22 as follows:

Regulation 22
amended
Chap. 62:01

(a) in subregulation (1)—

(i) by inserting immediately after the words
“subregulations (2)”, the words “, (2A)”;

(ii) by deleting the words “four thousand” and substituting
the words “forty thousand”;

(b) in subregulation (2), by deleting paragraphs (a), (b) and (c)
and substituting the following paragraphs:

“(a) for sales not exceeding
1,000,000 litres \$1,000.00

(b) for sales exceeding
1,000,000 litres but not
exceeding 5,000,000 litres \$2,000.00

(c) for sales exceeding
5,000,000 litres \$4,000.00.”;

(c) by inserting, immediately after subregulation (2), the
following subregulation:

“ (2A) In the case of a Pipeline Licence issued under
regulation 3(1)(f), the fee specified in subregulation (1)
shall be based on the capacity of the pipeline as follows:

(a) for capacity not exceeding
2 million cubic feet per
day \$5,000.00

(b) for capacity exceeding
2 million cubic feet per
day but not exceeding
100 million cubic feet per
day \$10,000.00

(c) for capacity exceeding
100 million cubic feet per
day \$40,000.00.”;

(d) in subregulation (3), by deleting the words “fifty dollars”
and substituting the words “one thousand dollars”; and

(e) by inserting immediately after subregulation (3), the
following subregulation:

“ (3A) In the case of a Transportation (other than by
pipeline) Licence, the annual fee shall be five hundred
dollars.”.
