ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(NATIONAL MILITARY TATTOO) ORDER, 2012

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (National Military Tattoo) Order, 2012.

2. This Order has effect from Monday 20th August, 2012 to Duration Sunday 26th August, 2012.

3. Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on Hart Street, Port-of-Spain, between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 11.00 p.m.

4. Taxi drivers who normally ply—

(a) the St. Ann's route, from the taxi stand on Hart Street, shall operate from the southern side of Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street; and

(b) the St. James route, from the taxi stand on Hart Street, shall operate from the northern side of Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Henry Street.

5. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
