MADE BY THE MINISTER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE CHIEF JUSTICE
UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 16) ORDER, 2012

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 16) Order, 2012.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

The Hon. Michael Jacob Beloff, QC	Of the Honourable Society of Gray's Inn: Barrister, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in November, 1967 and was appointed Queen's Counsel in 1981.

PART II

The Hon. Michael Jacob Beloff, QC, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following cause and any matter, suit or other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the cause, namely:
