TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 37 of 1970

AN ACT to provide for Supplementary Appropriation for the service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1970.

[Assented to 22nd October, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act, 1970. ^{Short title}

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of eight million, four hundred and ninety-eight thousand dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1970, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the said Schedule opposite a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of eight million, four hundred and ninety-eight dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that Head in the Supplementary Estimates for 1970.
