MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND INFRASTRUCTURE UNDER
SECTION 65(1) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (SANGRE GRANDE/EL DORADO) ORDER,
2012

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (Sangre Grande / Citation
El Dorado) Order, 2012.

PART I

SANGRE GRANDE

2. Motorists shall not park on—

Parking
prohibited

- (a) Brierley Street, between Picton Road and Ojoe Road;
- (b) Foster Road, between Brierley Street and Riverside Complex;
- (c) Old Post Office Road, between the Eastern Main Road and Railway Road No. 1; and
- (d) the Eastern Main Road, between Andrea Street and George Street on the—
 - (i) southern side on Monday, Wednesday and Friday;
and
 - (ii) northern side on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

3. Motorists shall not stop or wait on the northern or southern sides of the Eastern Main Road, between Andrea Street and the Roundabout at Ojoe Road.

Stopping and
waiting
prohibited

4. No person shall load or unload a goods vehicle on the northern side of the Eastern Main Road, between Andrea Street and the Roundabout at Ojoe Road.

Loading and
unloading
prohibited

5. A person shall load and unload a goods vehicle on the southern side of the Eastern Main Road, between Andrea Street and the Roundabout at Ojoe Road.

Loading and
unloading
permitted

6. Motorists shall proceed in—

One-way
traffic

- (a) a westerly direction on the Eastern Main Road, between Wallenvale Road and Railway Road at Guaico Junction,

between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays;

- (b) a southerly direction on Railway Extension Road, between the Eastern Main Road and Railway Road;
- (c) an easterly direction on Railway Road, between Railway Road and the Eastern Main Road;
- (d) an easterly direction on Brierley Street, between Picton Road and Toco Road;
- (e) a northerly and westerly direction on Henderson Street, between Toco Road and Foster Road;
- (f) a northerly direction on Guaico Village Street No. 1, between Railway Road and the Eastern Main Road;
- (g) a southerly direction on Guaico Village Street No. 3, between the Eastern Main Road and Railway Road Extension;
- (h) an easterly direction on River Road, between Ojoe Road and Foster Road;
- (i) a northerly direction on Guaico Village Street No. 4, between Railway Road Extension and the Eastern Main Road;
- (j) a southerly direction on George Street, between the Eastern Main Road and Juteram Street;
- (k) an easterly direction on Canton Street, between Paul Street and George Street;
- (l) a westerly direction on Oxford Street, between George Street and Paul Street;
- (m) a southerly direction on Cunapo Southern Road, between the Eastern Main Road and Mary Street;
- (n) an easterly direction on Mary Street, between Paul Street and Cunapo Southern Road;
- (o) a northerly direction on Michael Street, between the Eastern Main Road and Brierley Street; and
- (p) a southerly direction on Andre Street, between the Eastern Main Road and Cunapo Southern Road.

No entry 7. Motorists shall not enter Short Street, unless when driving a maxi-taxi or a vehicle marked "Sangre Grande Regional Corporation".

No entry to maxi-taxis 8. Maxi-taxi drivers proceeding—
 (a) east along the Eastern Main Road are prohibited from travelling further east along the route at Paul Street intersection; and

- (b) along the Eastern Main Road are prohibited from entering Railway Road No. 1.

9. Motorists proceeding east along the Eastern Main Road shall ^{Left turn only} turn left on Railway Road Guaico Junction, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays.

10. Motorists proceeding— Right of way

- (a) on Brierley Street at its intersection with Ramdass Street; and
- (b) east on Railway Road and Brierley Street at its intersection with Picton Road,

shall have the right of way.

11. Maxi-taxi drivers plying the Toco and Mayaro routes shall park ^{Maxi-taxi stand} on the southern side of Brierley Street and face east towards the eastern side of Railway Road No. 1 as marked.

12. Taxi drivers plying the— Taxi stand

- (a) Coalmine and Tamana routes shall park on the southern side of Mary Street, between George Street and Cunapo Southern Road, as marked;
- (b) Biche and Plum Mitán routes shall park on the eastern side of Cunapo Southern Road, between Andre Street and the Paint Shop, as marked, and face south by reversing from Mary Street;
- (c) Mayaro/Toco route shall park on the area north of Royal Castle, west of the old Bus Terminal compound, as marked;
- (d) Quash Trace route and known as “Foster Road taxis”, shall occupy Foster Road, north of River Road, as marked; and
- (e) Sookram Village/Sangre Grande District Hospital route and known as “Ojoe Road taxis” shall park on Ojoe Road from the Roundabout at Sangre Grande to Brierley Street and north of River Road, as marked.

13. Maxi-taxi drivers shall not ply for hire within one hundred ^{No plying for hire} metres in either direction between the maxi-taxi stand and the Eastern Main Road or Brierley Street.

PART II

EL DORADO

One-way
traffic

14. Motorists shall proceed in a—

- (a) northerly and westerly direction only on Mc Seveney Street Extension, between Persad Street and Mc Seveney Street, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays;
- (b) northerly and easterly direction only on Target Road Extension, between College Road and Target Road, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays; and
- (c) southerly direction on Target Road, between Karamath Street and Target Road Extension, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays.

No left turn

15. Motorists shall not turn left from College Road onto Target Road, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays.

Parking
prohibited

16. Motorists shall not park on—

- (a) Green Street, between El Dorado Road and Balthazar Street, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday except on public holidays;
- (b) Cassie Street, between Caura Royal Road and John King Street, between the hours of 4.00 p.m. and 8.00 p.m. except on public holidays;
- (c) the western side of Macoya Road, south and adjacent to the Macoya Market, from a point eighty metres to a point two hundred and fifty metres south of the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway; and
- (d) the eastern side of Macoya Road south and adjacent to Macoya Market, from a point one hundred and seventy metres to a point one hundred and ninety metres south of the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway.

GENERAL

17. A person who contravenes the provisions of this Order is liable to ^{Offence and} a fine of three thousand dollars or imprisonment for three months on ^{penalty} summary conviction.

18. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the ^{Removal and} commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in ^{impounding} contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and ^{of vehicles} unlawfully impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the ^{parked} Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
