NOTIFICATION

RECOGNITION OF AN APPROPRIATE ASSOCIATION

NOTICE is hereby given that, pursuant to regulation 4(1) of the Police Service (Recognition of an Appropriate Association) Regulations, 1992 (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”), made under section 24 of the Police Service Act (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), a Notification was published in the *Trinidad and Tobago Gazette*, Volume 43, No. 137 dated 13th August, 2004 at Item No. 1566, Legal Notice No. 231 of 2004 regarding an application for recognition as an appropriate recognized association of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service Social and Welfare Association.

And take notice that, more than fourteen days have expired from the date of publication of that Notification so, therefore, pursuant to Regulation 4(1)(b) of the Regulations the application is required to be determined in accordance with section 23(1) of the Act.

And take notice that the Minister of Finance (hereinafter referred to as “the Minister”), in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 23(1) of the Act, recognizes the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service and Social Welfare Association as an appropriate recognized association in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 8 of the Regulations.

And take notice that, pursuant to section 23(2) of the Act, the Minister hereby withdraws recognition of the First Division Officers’ Association as the appropriate recognized association.
