ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(ICC CRICKET WORLD CUP 2007) ORDER, 2007

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (ICC Cricket World Cup 2007) Order, 2007.
2. This Order shall have effect from 4.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m. on Wednesday 17th January, 2007.
3. Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on—
 - (a) Tragarete Road, between Alexandra Street and Roxy Roundabout;
 - (b) St. Clair Avenue;
 - (c) Elizabeth Street, between Tragarete Road and Hayes Street; and
 - (d) Havelock Street, between Tragarete Road and St. Clair Avenue.
4. (1) Parking is prohibited on the following streets, between Tragarete Road and Ariapita Avenue:
 - (a) Pole Carew Street;
 - (b) White Street;
 - (c) Rosalino Street;
 - (d) Luis Street;
 - (e) Alfredo Street;
 - (f) Carlos Street;
 - (g) Murray Street;
 - (h) Fitt Street;
 - (i) Cornelio Street;
 - (j) French Street; and
 - (k) Petra Street.

(2) Parking is prohibited on the following streets, between Pole Carew Street and French Street:

 - (a) Hunter Street;

(3) Parking is prohibited on the following :

- (a) Elizabeth Street;
- (b) Alexandra Street;
- (c) Gray Street;
- (d) Sweet Briar Road;
- (e) Alcazar Street;
- (f) Rust Street;
- (g) Herbert Street;
- (h) St. Clair Avenue;
- (i) Hayes Street;
- (j) Kavanagh Street;
- (k) Broome Street;
- (l) Serpentine Road;
- (m) Serpentine Place;
- (n) Maraval Road;
- (o) Queen's Park East;
- (p) Queen's Park West;
- (q) Circular Road;
- (r) Mary Street;
- (s) Flood Street; and
- (t) the northern side of Ariapita Avenue.

(4) Parking is prohibited on the following streets, between Warren Street and Wrightson Road:

- (a) Ana Street;
- (b) Gallus Street; and
- (c) Alberto Street;

(5) Parking is prohibited on the southern side of Ariapita Avenue from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.

5. (1) The following roads are closed to vehicular traffic:

- (a) Elizabeth Street, between Tragarete Road and Flood Street;

- (b) Tragarete Road, between Roxy Roundabout and Alexandra Street;
- (c) Sweet Briar Road, between Elizabeth Street and Gray Street;
- (d) St. Clair Avenue, between the Western Main Road and Gray Street;
- (e) Alexandra Street, between Tragarete Road and the southern end of Jackson Square;
- (f) Mary Street, between Hayes Street and the southern end of Jackson Square;
- (g) Hayes Street, between Maraval Road and Serpentine Road;
- (h) Kavanagh Street;
- (i) Broome Street;
- (j) Havelock Street;
- (k) Alfredo Street, between Tragarete Road and Robert Street;
- (l) Luis Street, between Tragarete Road and Robert Street;
- (m) Rosalino Street, between Tragarete Road and Robert Street;
- (n) White Street, between Tragarete Road and Robert Street; and
- (o) Pole Carew Street, between Tragarete Road and Robert Street.

(2) Notwithstanding clause 5(1), only vehicles with authorized permits will be granted access.

6. Vehicular traffic may access Wrightson Road from Ariapita Roads opened Avenue via Gallus Street or Alberto Street.

7. Motorists shall proceed in both directions on—

- (a) Ariapita Avenue;
- (b) French Street, between Tragarete Road and Ariapita Avenue;
- (c) Maraval Road, between Tragarete Road and St. Clair Roundabout;
- (d) Serpentine Road, between the Western Main Road and Maraval Road;
- (e) Robert Street, between French Street and Warren Street;
- (f) Gray Street, between Tragarete Road and Sweet Briar Road;

	(g) Sweet Briar Road, between Gray Street and Maraval Road; and						
	(h) Carlos Street, between Wrightson Road and Tragarete Road.						
One-way traffic	8. Motorists shall proceed as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) in a westerly direction along Robert Street, between Damian Street and Rosalino Street; (b) in an easterly direction along Hunter Street, between Damian Street and Warren Street; (c) in an easterly direction along Kelly-Kenny Street, between Damian Street and Warren Street; (d) in an easterly direction along Hamilton Street, between Damian Street and Warren Street; (e) in a southerly direction along Gray Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Sweet Briar Road; (f) in a westerly direction along St. Clair Avenue, between Maraval Road and Gray Street; (g) in a southerly direction along Gallus Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Wrightson Road; and (h) in a southerly direction along Alberto Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Wrightson Road. 						
Parking permitted	9. Patrons of the match may park at— <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) the Queen’s Park Savannah via the Grand Stand entrance, the Victoria Avenue entrance or the Casuals entrance; or (b) the Hasley Crawford Stadium via the main entrance, the St. John’s entrance or the Fitzblackman Drive entrance. 						
Shuttle service	10. A shuttle service will be provided to transport patrons from the Hasley Crawford Stadium to the Queen’s Park Oval.						
Emergency route	11. St. Clair Avenue is hereby designated the emergency route.						
Routes for vehicles on an emergency to medical institution	12. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked

14. Vehicles that are removed and impounded in accordance with clause 13 may be retrieved at the St. James Barracks, St. James after the prescribed fee has been paid. Retrieval of impounded vehicles
