THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(ST. JAMES, SAN FERNANDO AND TUNAPUNA CHILDREN'S
CARNIVAL PARADE OF BANDS) ORDER, 2007

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (St. James, San Fernando and Tunapuna Children's Carnival Parade of Bands) Order, 2007. Citation

2. This Order shall have effect in— Duration
- (a) St. James, from midday to 7.00 p.m. on February 11, 2007;
 - (b) San Fernando, from 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on February 18, 2007; and
 - (c) Tunapuna, from midday to 7.00 p.m. on February 18, 2007.

PART I

ST. JAMES

3. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on Western Main Road, between Roxy Roundabout and George Cabral Street. Road closed and parking prohibited

4. Vehicular traffic along Western Main Road— Vehicular traffic diverted
- (a) proceeding west, shall be diverted south onto Damian Street and onto Mucurapo Road; and
 - (b) proceeding east, shall be diverted north onto George Cabral Street, east onto Kathleen Street, onto Delhi Street and onto Barbados Road.

5. Parking is prohibited on the following streets: Parking prohibited
- (a) Damian Street;
 - (b) George Cabral Street;
 - (c) Kathleen Street; and
 - (d) Delhi Street.

Roads closed

6. (1) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on—

- (a) Salazar Street;
- (b) Jerry Street;
- (c) Bournes Road;
- (d) Brunton Street;
- (e) Mooneram Street; and
- (f) Bombay Street,

from Church Street in a southerly direction.

(2) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on—

- (a) Calcutta Street;
- (b) Madras Street;
- (c) Agra Street; and
- (d) Bengal Street,

from Delhi Street in a southerly direction.

(3) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on—

- (a) Luckput Street;
- (b) Mathura Street;
- (c) Romeo Street; and
- (d) Lazare Street,

from Carlton Avenue in a southerly direction.

(4) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on Ethel Street from Bay Road in a northerly direction.

(5) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on—

- (a) Dengue Street;
- (b) Vidale Street;
- (c) Clarence Street; and
- (d) Nizam Street,

from Anderson Street in a northerly direction.

(6) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on—

- (a) Nepaul Street;

- (b) Cawnpore Street;
- (c) Benares Street; and
- (d) Lucknow Street,

from Hyderabad Street in a northerly direction.

(7) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on Ganges Street in a northerly direction, except for the residents of Ganges Street.

PART II
SAN FERNANDO

7. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on—

- (a) Royal Road;
- (b) Coffee Street; and
- (c) Ciperro Street.

prohibited

8. Vehicular traffic proceeding west along Naparima-Mayaro Road shall turn right onto Circular Road.

Right turn
only

9. Vehicular traffic proceeding west along Navet Road, shall turn left onto Bertrand Street.

Left turn only

PART III
TUNAPUNA

10. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on—

- (a) Eastern Main Road, between Tunapuna Road and El Dorado Road/Macoya Extension; and
- (b) Fairley Street from Sheriff Street.

Roads closed
and parking
prohibited

11. Vehicular traffic along Eastern Main Road—

- (a) proceeding east, shall be diverted north onto Tunapuna Road, east onto Green Street, south onto El Dorado Road and east onto Eastern Main Road; and
- (b) proceeding west, shall be diverted north onto El Dorado Road, west onto Green Street, south onto Fairley Street, west onto Sheriff Street, south onto Tunapuna Road and west along Eastern Main Road.

12. Parking is prohibited on—

- (a) Tunapuna Road between Eastern Main Road and Green Street;
- (b) Green Street, between Tunapuna Road and El Dorado Road;
- (c) Sheriff Street between Fairley Street and Tunapuna Road;
and
- (d) Eastern Main Road, between Tunapuna Road and El Dorado Road and Macoya Extension.

Removal and
impounding
of vehicles

13. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
