MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO FORTY-FIFTH  
ANNIVERSARY OF INDEPENDENCE CELEBRATIONS)  
ORDER, 2007

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Republic of Trinidad and Tobago Forty-fifth Anniversary of Independence Celebrations) Order, 2007.

2. This Order has effect from 6.00 a.m. on Friday 31st August, 2007 to 1.00 a.m. on Saturday 1st September, 2007.

3. (1) Parking is prohibited—

Parking  
prohibited

(a) from 6.00 a.m. to 12.00 midday on—

- (i) Queen's Park East;
- (ii) Queen's Park West;
- (iii) Circular Road;
- (iv) Maraval Road;
- (v) Cipriani Boulevard;
- (vi) Serpentine Road;
- (vii) Charlotte Street, between the junction of Queen's Park East and Queen's Park West and New Street;
- (viii) Rapsey Street;
- (ix) Lucknow Street;
- (x) Robert Street;
- (xi) Tragarete Road, between Colville Street/Cipriani Boulevard and Roxy Roundabout;
- (xii) Western Main Road, between Tragarete Road and Long Circular Road;
- (xiii) St. Clair Avenue, between Elizabeth Street and Broome Street;

- (xiv) Saddle Road, between Maraval Roundabout and Rapsey Street;
- (xv) Panka Street;
- (xvi) Gaston Johnson Street;
- (xvii) Keate Street;
- (xviii) Chancery Lane; and
- (xix) Long Circular Road, between Barbados Road and Western Main Road.

(b) from 12.00 midday on Friday 31st August, 2007, to 1.00 a.m. on Saturday 1st September, 2007 on—

- (i) Queen's Park West, from Chancery Lane to St. Clair Roundabout;
- (ii) Maraval Road, from St. Clair Roundabout to Maraval Roundabout;
- (iii) Circular Road, from Maraval Roundabout to St. Ann's Roundabout;
- (iv) Queen's Park East, from St. Ann's Roundabout to Queen's Park West; and
- (v) Charlotte Street, from Queen's Park West to New Street.

Vehicular  
traffic  
prohibited

4. Vehicular traffic is prohibited from 6.00 a.m. to 12.00 midday,  
on—

- (a) Queen's Park West, between Cipriani Boulevard and Maraval Road;
- (b) Tragarete Road, between Cipriani Boulevard and Roxy Roundabout;
- (c) Western Main Road, between Lucknow Street and Roxy Roundabout;
- (d) Circular Road;
- (e) Maraval Road;
- (f) Saddle Road, between Maraval Road and Rapsey Street;
- (g) St. Clair Avenue, between Elizabeth Street and Western Main Road; and
- (h) Serpentine Road, between Flood Street and Western Main Road.

5. From 6.00 a.m. to 12.00 midday vehicular traffic shall proceed— One-way traffic
- (a) south along Cipriani Boulevard, between Queen's Park West and Tragarete Road; and
  - (b) east along Queen's Park West, between Frederick Street and Queen's Park East.
6. From 6.00 a.m. to 12.00 midday vehicular traffic shall proceed in Two-way traffic both directions along the following:
- (a) Rapsey Street, between Saddle Road and Wainwright Street; and
  - (b) Queen's Park East, between Queen's Park West and St. Ann's Roundabout.
7. (1) Vehicular traffic proceeding— Traffic diverted
- (a) south along Saddle Road shall turn west onto Rapsey Street, onto Barbados Road, south onto Long Circular Road and onto Western Main Road;
  - (b) east along Western Main Road shall turn south onto Lucknow Street, west onto Panka street, south onto Gaston Johnson Street and onto Mucurapo Road; and
  - (c) north to St. Ann's shall proceed north along Frederick Street from Keate Street, east along Queen's Park West and north along Queen's Park East to the St. Ann's Roundabout.
- (2) Vehicular traffic may enter and exit St. Clair via Alexandra Street, Elizabeth Street, Serpentine Road, Prada Street, Wainwright Street and Rapsey Street, as directed by a police officer on duty.
8. Motorists may, from 6.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m., park in the Queen's Parking in Queen's Park Savannah Park Savannah, entering the driveway opposite St. Ann's Roundabout, as directed by a police officer on duty.
9. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal of vehicles unlawfully parked commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
