ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(PRE-CARNIVAL) ORDER, 2006

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Pre-Carnival) Order, 2006.

PRE-CARNIVAL FUNCTIONS AT THE GRAND STAND
QUEEN'S PARK SAVANNAH

2. Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, motorists attending any pre-carnival functions at the Grand Stand may park their vehicles on the Queen's Park Savannah during the period commencing two hours before the start of the function and ending two hours after the close of the function.

3. Clauses 4 and 5 of this Order shall have effect on the following times and dates:

- (a) from 6.00 p.m. on Thursday 16th February, 2006 to 2.00 a.m. on Friday 17th February, 2006;
- (b) from 6.00 p.m. on Tuesday 21st February, 2006 to 2.00 a.m. on Wednesday 22nd February, 2006; and
- (c) from 5.00 p.m. on Friday 24th February, 2006 to 2.00 a.m. on Saturday 25th February, 2006.

4. Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) Chancery Lane;
- (b) Albion Street, between Stanmore Avenue and Chancery Lane;
- (c) Dundonald Street, between Queen's Park West and Albion Street;
- (d) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
- (e) Keate Street;
- (f) Frederick Street, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West; and
- (g) Dere Street.

Parking

Parking
permitted

5. Parking is permitted on the following roads:
- (a) Stanmore Avenue, between Tranquillity Street and Queen's Park West, on the western side only;
 - (b) Victoria Avenue, between Tranquillity Street and Queen's Park West, on the western side only;
 - (c) Cipriani Boulevard, on the eastern side only;
 - (d) Cummins Lane, on the southern side only;
 - (e) Tranquillity Street, on the southern side only; and
 - (f) Dundonald Street, on the eastern side, south of Melville Lane, for Public Transport Service Corporation buses only.

JUNIOR CARNIVAL PARADE

Duration

6. Clauses 7 to 12 of this Order shall have effect from 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on Saturday 25th February, 2006.

7. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on the following roads:
- (a) Knox Street, between St. Vincent Street and Frederick Street;
 - (b) Hart Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street;
 - (c) Abercromby Street, between South Quay and Duke Street;
 - (d) Independence Square North, between Henry Street and Edward Street;
 - (e) Independence Square South, between Henry Street and Edward Street;
 - (f) Broadway, between South Quay and Independence Square South;
 - (g) Frederick Street;
 - (h) Queen Street, between Henry Street and St. Vincent Street;
 - (i) Duke Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
 - (j) Park Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
 - (k) Oxford Street, between Charlotte Street and Pembroke Street;
 - (l) New Street, between Charlotte Street and Pembroke Street;
 - (m) Gordon Street, between Charlotte Street and Pembroke Street;

- (n) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Pembroke Street;
- (o) Duprey Drive;
- (p) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane;
- (q) Charlotte Street, between Oxford Street and Queen's Park East;
- (r) Queen's Park East, between Queen's Park West and Jerningham Avenue; and
- (s) Henry Street, between Park Street and Oxford Street.

8. Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

Parking prohibited

- (a) Chancery Lane;
- (b) Dundonald Street, between Queen's Park West and New Street; and
- (c) Albion Street, between Chancery Lane and Victoria Avenue.

9. Vehicular traffic shall proceed as follows:

One-way traffic

- (a) on Keate Street, between Pembroke Street and Chancery Lane, in a westerly direction;
- (b) on Gordon Street, between Pembroke Street and St. Vincent Street, in a westerly direction; and
- (c) on Albion Street, in a westerly direction.

10. Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, vehicular traffic may proceed in both directions along Gordon Street, between Chancery Lane and Frederick Street.

Two-way traffic

11. Taxis shall operate as follows:

Taxi stands

St. Ann's Taxi Stand

- (a) taxis that ply for hire on Hart Street, shall ply for hire on the southern side of Queen Street, between St. Vincent Street and Edward Street;

St. James Taxi Stand

- (b) taxis that ply for hire on Hart Street, shall ply for hire on the western side of Edward Street, between Independence Square North and Queen Street;

Ice House / Broadway and Marine Square Taxi Stand

- (c) taxis that ply for hire on the southern side of Independence Square North, between Abercromby Street and St. Vincent Street and on the eastern and western sides of Cipriani Circle, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South, shall ply for hire on the northern and southern sides of Independence Square North, between St. Vincent Street and Wrightson Road;

San Fernando and Chaguanas Taxi Stand

- (d) taxis that ply for hire on Broadway, between South Quay and Independence Square South, shall ply for hire—
- (i) from the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway, west of Broadway, facing east (San Fernando taxis); and
 - (ii) from the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway, east of Broadway, facing east (Chaguanas taxis);

Long Circular / Wrightson Road Taxi Stand

- (e) taxis that ply for hire on Chacon Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall ply for hire on the southern side of Independence Square South, between St. Vincent Street and Wrightson Road, facing west; and

Diego Martin / Petit Valley Taxi Stand

- (f) taxis that ply for hire on South Quay, between Broadway and Abercromby Street, shall ply for hire on the northern side of Independence Square South, between St. Vincent Street and Wrightson Road, facing west.

Band Route

12. Bands shall proceed along the following routes:
- (a) from Knox Street, south along Abercromby Street to South Quay;
 - (b) east along South Quay to Broadway;
 - (c) north along Broadway to Independence Square North;
 - (d) north along Frederick Street to Oxford Street;
 - (e) east along Oxford Street to Charlotte Street;
 - (f) north along Charlotte Street to the top of Memorial Park;
- and

(g) west along Queen's Park West, turning right onto the Frederick Street entrance of the Queen's Park Savannah to the Grand Stand.

13. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
