ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(INDIA vs. WEST INDIES) (CRICKET) ORDER, 2006

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary ^{Citation} Provisions) (India vs. West Indies) (Cricket) Order, 2006.
2. This Order shall have effect from midnight on Thursday 25th ^{Duration} May, 2006 to 8.00 p.m. on Friday 26th May, 2006.
3. Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on—
 - (a) Tragarete Road, between Maraval Road and Roxy ^{Vehicular traffic and parking prohibited} Roundabout;
 - (b) St. Clair Avenue;
 - (c) Elizabeth Street, between Tragarete Road and Hayes Street; and
 - (d) Havelock Street, between Tragarete Road and St. Clair Avenue.
4. (1) Parking is prohibited on the following streets between ^{Parking prohibited} Tragarete Road and Ariapita Avenue:
 - (a) Pole Carew Street;
 - (b) White Street;
 - (c) Gallus Street;
 - (d) Alberto Street;
 - (e) Rosalino Street;
 - (f) Luis Street;
 - (g) Alfredo Street;
 - (h) Carlos Street;
 - (i) Murray Street;
 - (j) Fitt Street;
 - (k) Cornelio Street; and
 - (l) French Street.

(2) Parking is prohibited on the following streets between French Street and Pole Carew Street:

- (a) Hunter Street;
- (b) Robert Street;
- (c) Warren Street; and
- (d) Baden Powel Street.

(3) Parking is prohibited on the following:

- (a) Elizabeth Street;
- (b) Alexandra Street;
- (c) Gray Street;
- (d) Sweet Briar Road;
- (e) Alcazar Street;
- (f) Rust Street;
- (g) Herbert Street;
- (h) Hayes Street;
- (i) Kavanagh Street;
- (j) Broome Street;
- (k) Serpentine Road;
- (l) Serpentine Place;
- (m) Havelock Street;
- (n) Flood Street;
- (o) Mary Street;
- (p) Maraval Road; and
- (q) Queen's Park Savannah, between Picton Street and St. Clair Roundabout.

5. Patrons of the match may park at the Queen's Park Savannah, via all the approved entrances along Queen's Park West.

One-way
traffic

6. Motorists shall proceed as follows:

- (a) in a westerly direction along Flood Street, between Maraval Road and Serpentine Place;
- (b) in a northerly direction along Serpentine Road, between the Western Main Road and Maraval Road; and
- (c) in an easterly direction along Robert Street, between Pole Carew Street and Damian Street.

7. Motorists shall proceed in both directions on— Two-way traffic
- (a) Robert Street, between Colville Street and Pole Carew Street;
 - (b) Ariapita Avenue;
 - (c) French Street;
 - (d) Maraval Road; and
 - (e) Circular Road.

8. (1) St. Clair Avenue is hereby designated an emergency route. Emergency route
- (2) Pedestrian traffic is prohibited on St. Clair Avenue.

9. In cases of emergency, motorists proceeding from the Queen's Park Oval to a medical institution listed in the first column shall proceed along the route stated in the Second Column— Routes for vehicles on an emergency to medical institution

Port-of-Spain General Hospital Port-of-Spain	East along St. Clair Avenue, north along Maraval Road, east along Circular Road, south onto Queen's Park East and onto Charlotte Street.
St. Clair Medical Centre, St. Clair	East along St. Clair Avenue to the emergency entrance of the institution.
Seventh Day Adventist Hospital Cocorite	West along St. Clair Avenue, west along the Western Main Road, Cocorite
West Shore Medical Cocorite	West along St. Clair Avenue, west along the Western Main Road, Cocorite

Removal and

10. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.

11. Vehicles that are removed and impounded in accordance with clause 10 may be retrieved at St. James Barracks, St. James after the prescribed fee has been paid and after these traffic restrictions have expired.
