MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO FORTY-FOURTH
ANNIVERSARY OF INDEPENDENCE CELEBRATIONS)
ORDER, 2006

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary ^{Citation} Provisions) (Republic of Trinidad and Tobago Forty-fourth Anniversary of Independence Celebrations) Order, 2006.

2. This Order has effect from 6.00 a.m. on Thursday 31st August, ^{Duration} 2006 to 1.00 a.m. on Friday 1st September, 2006.

3. (1) Parking is prohibited—

Parking
prohibited

(a) from 6.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. on—

- (i) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Cipriani Boulevard;
- (ii) Chancery Lane, between Keate Street and Queen's Park West;
- (iii) Dere Street;
- (iv) Albion Street;
- (v) Gordon Street; and
- (vi) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Park Street;

(b) from 6.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m., on Park Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street;

(c) from 6.00 a.m. to midday on—

- (i) the Western Main Road, from its junction with Tragarete Road to its junction with Long Circular Road; and
- (ii) Tragarete Road;

- (d) from 6.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m., on Long Circular Road, between the Western Main Road and Patna Street; and
- (e) from midday on Thursday 31st August, 2006 to 1.00 a.m. on Friday 1st September, 2006 on—
 - (i) Queen's Park West, from Chancery Lane to the Queen's Royal College Roundabout;
 - (ii) Maraval Road, from the Queen's Royal College Roundabout to the St. Clair Roundabout;
 - (iii) Circular Road, from the St. Clair Roundabout to the St. Ann's Roundabout;
 - (iv) Queen's Park East, from the St. Ann's Roundabout to Queen's Park West; and
 - (v) Charlotte Street, from Queen's Park West to New Street.

(2) Notwithstanding subclause (1), a driver of a taxi, plying the taxi for hire, may park his taxi in the taxi stand on the western side of Dere Street.

Vehicular
traffic
prohibited

4. Vehicular traffic is prohibited—

- (a) from 9.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. on—
 - (i) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane;
 - (ii) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Abercromby Street;
 - (iii) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Park Street; and
 - (iv) Pembroke Street, between Keate Street and Gordon Street;
- (b) from 9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m., on Park Street, between Henry Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (c) from 9.00 a.m. to midday, on Tragarete Road; and
- (d) from 10.00 a.m. to midday, on the Western Main Road, between Damian Street and Lucknow Street.

Entry into
Queen's
Park
Savannah

5. A motorist shall enter the Queen's Park Savannah—

- (a) through the entrance opposite Whitehall, where the vehicle forms part of the Independence Anniversary Parade;

- (b) through the entrance opposite Frederick Street, where the vehicle belongs to—
 - (i) the Defence Force;
 - (ii) the Police Service;
 - (iii) the Fire Service;
 - (iv) the Prison Service; or
 - (v) a voluntary organization; and
- (c) through the entrance opposite Frederick Street, where the vehicle is being used to transport personnel of the organizations mentioned in paragraph (b).

6. A motorist may, from 6.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m., park his vehicle on the Queen's Park Savannah, south of the Grand Stand, as directed by a police officer on duty. Parking on Queen's Park Savannah

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
