ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(FORMAL OPENING OF THE 2006–2007 LAW TERM OF
THE SUPREME COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD
AND TOBAGO) ORDER, 2006

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Formal opening of the 2006–2007 Law Term of the Supreme Court of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago) Order, 2005.

2. This Order has effect from 6.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. on Monday Duration 18th September, 2006.

3. (1) Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) St. Vincent Street, between Duke Street and Independence Square North;
- (b) Sackville Street, between Richmond Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (c) Abercromby Street, between Independence Square North and Park Street;
- (d) Knox Street, between St. Vincent Street and Frederick Street;
- (e) Edward Street, between Independence Square North and Park Street;
- (f) Hart Street;
- (g) Duke Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (h) Pembroke Street, between Knox Street and Park Street;
- (i) Henry Street, between Independence Square North and Park Street; and
- (j) Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Edward Street.

Parking
prohibited

(2) Notwithstanding clause 3(1), vehicles belonging to the Police Service and the Defence Force may be parked on the eastern side of Edward Street, between Queen Street and Sackville Street.

(3) Parking is prohibited on the grounds of the Red House.

Roads closed
to vehicular
traffic

4. (1) Vehicular traffic is prohibited from 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on the following roads :

- (a) St. Vincent Street, between Duke Street and Queen Street;
- (b) Hart Street;
- (c) Abercromby Street, between Independence Square North and Park Street;
- (d) Knox Street.
- (e) Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Edward Street; and
- (f) Edward Street, between Independence Square North and Sackville Street.

(2) Notwithstanding clause 4(1), taxis plying the St. Ann's route may be parked and access Queen Street from Frederick Street.

Vehicular
traffic

5. From 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. vehicular traffic proceeding—

- (a) east along Sackville Street, shall turn north onto Edward Street;
- (b) west along Duke Street, shall turn north onto Pembroke Street; and
- (c) south on St. Vincent Street, shall turn west onto Duke Street.

Taxi routes

6. Taxis that normally ply—

- (a) the St. Ann's route from Hart Street, shall operate from the southern side of Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street; and
- (b) the St. James route from Hart Street, shall operate from the western side of Henry Street, between Prince Street and Duke Street.

Removal
and
impounding
of vehicles

7. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
